

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Week of February 5, 2024

Crews continue to work in the storm channel on the west side of the bridge.

PROJECT UDATE

Southbound Bridge Span Crews are driving piles, or steel beams, into the storm channel; placing rebar cages around the piles; and filling the cages with concrete to provide foundation support for the new southbound Dune Palms bridge span. Project neighbors can expect to hear pounding noises during construction work hours from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., through mid-February.

Northbound Bridge Span

Crews are constructing and placing concrete for the northbound bridge span sidewalk.

Dune Palms Road

Dune Palms Road on the north side of the bridge in the construction area has been demolished to make space to construct the southbound bridge span. Crews will be hauling away bridge rubble this week, please watch for trucks entering and entering the job site.
